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# Establishment of a community of practice on the safe handling of hazardous drugs in Quebec

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## Context

Communities of practice (CoP) as a mean of knowledge transfer is gaining interest in Quebec (e.g. pharmacovigilance and clinical research support CoP were created).



2021 update of the <u>safe handling of hazardous drugs</u> <u>Prevention Guide</u> from the Quebec health and safety association (ASSTSAS): presented an opportunity to develop a CoP on the safe handling of hazardous drugs.

### Objective

To describe the establishment of a CoP on the safe handling of hazardous drugs in Quebec.

# Methods

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•6 stages identified (Fig 1)

- Obtaining support
- Identification of a governance structure and expert members volunteering to launch the CoP
- Identification of designated members
  - Identification of communication tools
  - Identification of operating rules
  - Identification of objectives for the first year
  - Fig 1. Six stages for establishing a Community of practice (CoP)




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upport of the ASSTSAS obtained in April 2021.

- 2 he members of the Committee on the safe handling of hazardous drugs agreed to participate in April 2021.
  - 31 directors of pharmacy departments contacted in May 2021 to identify members
    - 1 pharmacist and 1 nurse targeted per center
- As of September 13, 2021, 84 designated members represent 29 centers.

4 virtual meetings and document sharing with Microsoft Teams<sup>®</sup>.

- 5 Members are invited to discuss/share their practices on the group:
- Questions about the Guide collected and shared with the ASSTSAS.
- Meeting topics planned based on questions received.
- Opportunity for the members to present their centers' practices.
